Subject: Sulfoxaflor

The following comments are being submitted in regard to the decision by the 9<sup>th</sup> Circuit Court of Appeals to vacate EPA's registration of sulfoxaflor. These comments are being submitted on behalf of the Western Integrated Pest Management Center and provide input on the use of sulfoxaflor in Hawai'i.

Because sulfoxaflor is new to the Hawai'i marketplace, there is little information about its use.

However, there is some interest in the potential of sulfoxaflor products in Hawai'ii due to the extensive number of crops labeled.

Closer SC and Sequoia (both 62719-623) are registered on watercress and licensed in Hawaii. The target pests are aphids and leafhoppers which are occasional, but serious insect pests of watercress. There are very few new registrations that the watercress growers can use for insect control. However, we don't know how much sulfoxaflor, if any, is being used in watercress.

Also, Xxpire (62719-767), a product which is the combination of sulfoxaflor and spinetoram, has been mentioned for use for the production of poinsettias and in non-residential landscapes. Details about these uses, such as target pest(s) and efficacy of Xxpire are not known.
