Diazinon and Malathion are staples in cropping systems for pineapple, macadamia, corn and vegetable crops in the Hawaiian islands and Guam. They help control mealy bugs, scale insects and Lepidoptera pests. They serve as important tools in IPM for pineapple growers, the papaya industry as well as corn and seed production. Since chlorpyrifos and endosulfan are no longer options, these products are important in maintaining healthy crops for human consumption .
